

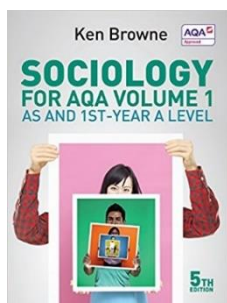
### **How you can help your child in Social Sciences:**

The best way to help your child is to take an interest in what they are learning. Ask them to teach you about theory and concepts they have been learning about. Test their definitions. Encourage them to read as much as they can and watch appropriate material on television that can help to broaden their knowledge and apply theory to current affairs. Help them to organise their folder to check work is in correct sections.

It would be helpful to be aware of the exam board and learning content for topics, all of which is recorded in their subject handbook.
