September to October half term	<p>St Wilfrid's Drop-in-Centre – Bishop's Walk (3.9.18 – 12.10.18) Headteacher, one of SMT or another representative does the Bishop's Walk as a sponsored event. 	<p>Pink Day Friday 19.10.18 (6th Form & 1804 Team) 6th Form ONLY in themed dress. Y7-11 non uniform but wear a pink garment. 6th form sell ribbons etc.)</p>						
November to December half term	<p>1. Poppy Appeal (Mon 5th Nov to Fri 16th November) One form from each year group (HOY Rota) to sell poppies to their own year group and in/around the school each day. Boxes to be returned to Reception.</p>

ADVENT FUNDRAISING: LAUNCH IN ASSEMBLIES w/c 19th /11/18 Each year <u>chooses</u> a charity (Assemblies week 19th – 23rd November) and invites in a guest speaker from the charity to speak and plans a fundraising activity to support their year groups charity. Money raised (26.11.18 to 21.12.18) to be handed in to reception marked with form name.</p>
